While visitors and residents look to escape the heat during summer months, Jebel Jais offers outdoor adventures and diverse scenery at significantly cooler temperatures (10°C cooler on average). Jebel Jais is home to Jais Flight, the world's longest zipline experience, the family-friendly Jais Sledder as well as hiking trails for all levels and dining at 1484 by Puro, the highest restaurant in the UAE.

Jais Sledder

Reaching speeds upwards of 40 kilometres per hour as you hurtle down Jebel Jais swerving through glorious panoramas with views of the spectacular coastline. The Jais Sledder sits comfortably on a low-slung track. The fully-controllable ride takes about eight minutes to cover 1,885 exhilarating metres of hairpin curves and undulating waves from top to bottom.

Jais Flight

Jais Flight, the longest zipline in the world (2.83km long), is located on Jebel Jais, the highest mountain in the UAE. Soar across jagged mountain peaks and swoop through deep ravines at speeds of up to 150 kmph. Three minutes of adrenaline-pumping adventure at 1,680 metres above the Arabian Gulf will leave you with a once-in-a-lifetime sense of superhero magic.



Jais Sky Tour

Jais Sky Tour takes you through a complex route of six ziplines that range from just 337 metres to well over 1 km. The ziplines give you an extraordinary bird's eye view as you weave through the towering Hajar Mountain range wearing a specially fitted harness, traveling at an average speed of 60kmph. The entire experience takes 2 hours as you navigate seven platforms connected by six ziplines.

Al Jazirah Al Hamra

As the last standing authentic village in the UAE dating back to 17th century; Al Jazirah Al Hamra is an archeological marvel. The ancient pearling village features all elements of a traditional town, including a fortress, a small market, several mosques and a variety of houses. It's on the UNESCO World Heritage Cultural Tentative List, representing classic architecture and the traditional lifestyle in the Middle East.

Golf

Ras Al Khaimah boasts two world class golf courses. Al Hamra Golf Club, became the first course in the region to host back to back DP World Tour events. The Harradine designed course, managed by Troon Golf, is cleverly designed around five lagoons. Tower Links Golf Club is a Par 72 course located amongst a mangrove reserve and framed by the dramatic Hajar Mountains. Both courses are set up for golfers of all level and both venues provide fantastic restaurants and lounges.





Malls and Souks

Dhayah Fort

Dhayah Fort is the only hill fort remaining in the UAE and is on the UNESCO World Heritage Tentative List. It dates back to the Late Bronze Age (1600 – 1300 BC) when locals used it for settlement and fortification. The twin-peaked golden mud-brick fortress was built during the 19th century and restored in the late 1990s. It is certainly worth climbing the zigzagging steps to bear witness to the spectacular views of the lush palm gardens, the sea and the dramatic mountains.

Al Wadi Nature Reserve

The protected nature reserve spans 500 hectares at Ritz Carlton Al Wadi and is home to a diverse range of free-roaming wildlife. Visitors can learn about the desert ecosystem and watch more than 50 species of birds, prized falcons and owls, beautiful Arabian horses, bombastic camels, the rare Arabian oryx, sand gazelles, and, if you are lucky, the occasional desert fox in their natural environment.




