Ras Al Khaimah Culture & History Itinerary

Day 1

- Celebrate the fascinating history of pearl diving in Ras Al Khaimah at the Suwaidi Pearl Farm, where you can try hand in opening your own oysters to see if you've found a pearl to take home.
- After a hearty lunch, you'll head inland to Dhayah Fort to discover the twin-peaked fortress that was built during the 19th century and restored in 2011. One of Ras Al Khaimah's most important sites – Dhayah Fort is also listed on the UNESCO World Heritage Site Tentative List.
- In the evening, explore the terracotta sands of Ras Al Khaimah in a Bassata Village desert camp.

Day 2

- Start your day by exploring the enchanting Al Jazeera Al Hamra Heritage Village, once a thriving hub for pearl diving and fishing. Wander through the well-preserved structures that tell the stories of the Emirati community and its rich maritime history.
- For lunch, indulge in authentic Emirati cuisine at Sseek, where traditional flavors and warm hospitality come together. Savor delicious dishes that reflect the region's culinary heritage, making for a delightful dining experience.
- As the sun begins to set, head to Camp 1770, the UAE's highest camp. Here, you can unwind while taking in breathtaking panoramic views of the desert landscape, enjoying the magical transition from day to night in this stunning setting.

Day 3

- Start your day with an exhilarating sunrise hot air balloon ride by ActionFlight, soaring almost 3,000 meters above the ground and taking in breathtaking views of Ras Al Khaimah. After this unforgettable experience, enjoy a delicious breakfast at the Tower Links Golf Club to fuel your next adventure.
- Next, delve into the rich history of the emirate at The National Museum of Ras Al Khaimah, where captivating exhibits await you. Finally, treat yourself to a quick sweet bite at Ashuk Ice Cream, the UAE's oldest ice cream café, and indulge in delightful flavors that have stood the test of time!
- Spend the afternoon surrounded by some of Ras Al Khaimah's native wildlife and learn about these fascinating animals from the expert guides at the Ritz-Carlton Al Wadi Desert resort.
- In the evening, enjoy an authentic farm-to-table dinner at the Ritz-Carlton's Farmhouse.

Driving Time

Ras Al Khaimah is easily accessible for regional and international visitors. It is also well served by excellent bus and taxi services, enabling you to reach our diverse areas of natural beauty, historical treasures and modern resorts.

A wide range of maps and brochures are also available to help you make the most of your visit to Ras Al Khaimah.

Ras Al Khaimah is only a short 45-min drive away from Dubai International Airport (DXB), and 1,5h drive away from Abu Dhabi International Airport (AUH).

Weather

Generally, Ras Al Khaimah is a few degrees cooler than its sister Emirates because of its 64-kilometre coastline and the Hajar mountain range.

With a cool sea breeze and slightly less dry in the winter than its neighbors, temperatures in the Emirate vary from 18-25°C in January to 29-43°C in July, with eight to ten daily hours of sunshine all year round.

The Jebel Jais mountain peak provides breathtaking vistas and a cooling microclimate with temperatures less than 10 degrees Fahrenheit found at sea level.

Packing Tips

Depending on the time of year you visit, ensure that you take the proper clothing to protect you. Bring plenty of layering clothes and a warm hat during the winter months. Wear a hat to shade you from the sun and plenty of sun cream to protect you from the sun's harmful rays in the summer.

Weather conditions can change quickly. It is advisable to wear multiple thin layers so that it is easy to maintain your optimal body temperature if the temperature rises or falls.

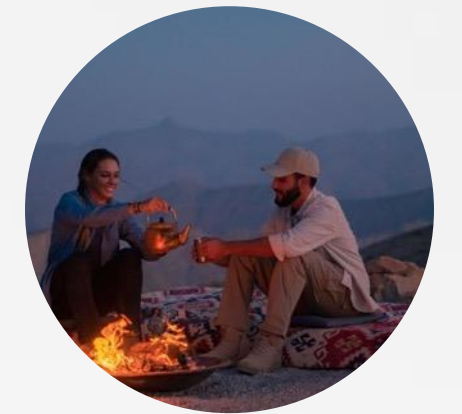

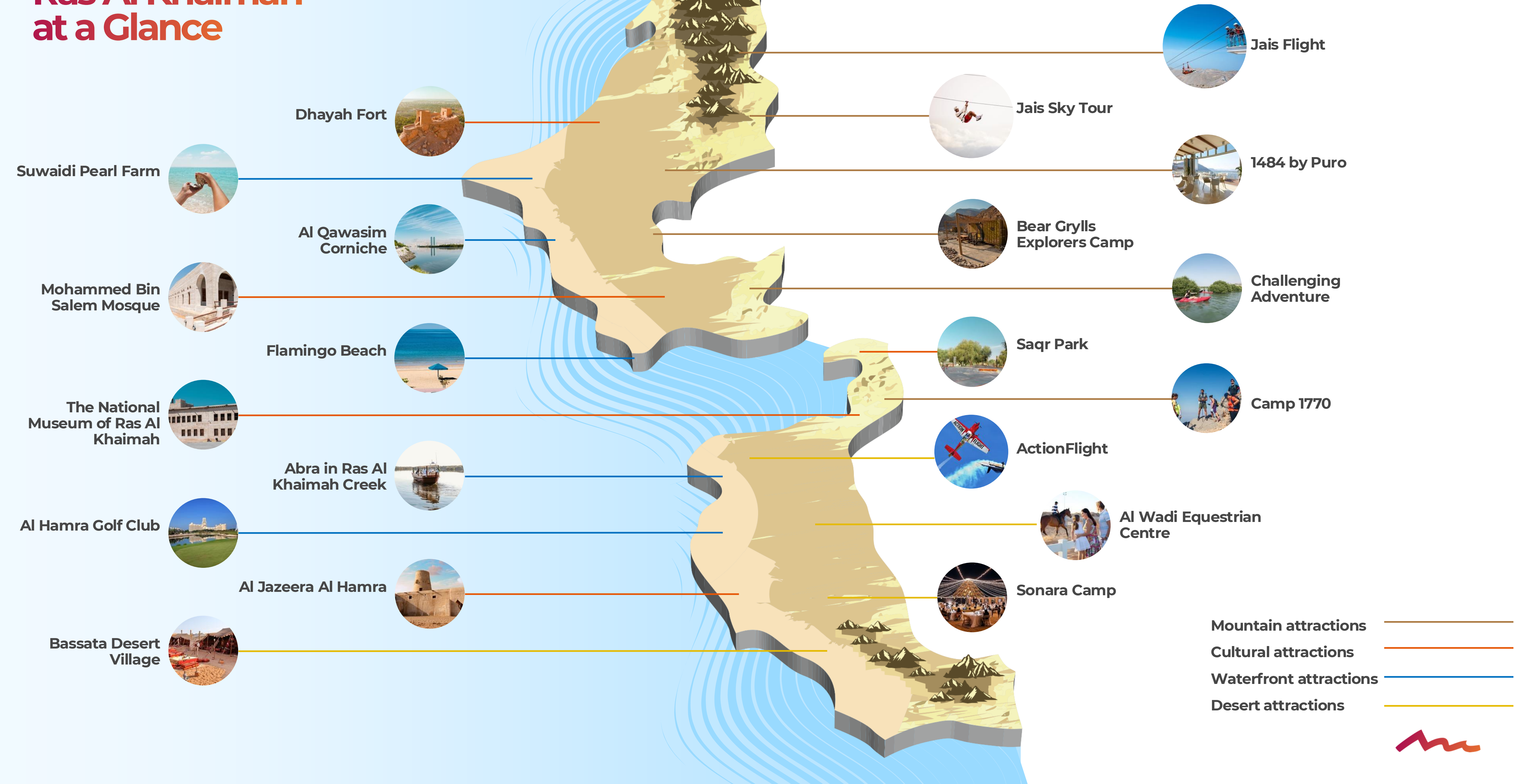
