- In the afternoon, embark on an exhilarating Yellow Boat tour, cruising along the coastline and taking in panoramic views of Ras Al Khaimah's stunning natural beauty. As the sun sets, find a cozy spot to relax and take in the evening by the water.

Day 4

- Start your day with a serene kayaking trip through the mangroves on Mina Al Arab, exploring the quiet, lush waterways and watching the local birdlife as it flits between the trees.
- After a restful afternoon, set sail on a luxurious sunset yacht trip, gliding along the coast as the sun dips below the horizon.
- As the golden hour paints the sky, enjoy the beauty of the sea before docking for a memorable dinner at a beachside restaurant.

Day 5

- For your final day, enjoy a breakfast at The Bay overlooking the lush greens at the Al Hamra Golf Club, where you can take a few swings or simply relax and take in the tranquil views.
- Later, take a scenic Abra ride along Ras Al Khaimah Creek, allowing you to explore the city from a traditional wooden boat. In the afternoon, stroll along Corniche Al Qawasim, stopping for a lunch at Space Café to enjoy a casual meal with panoramic views of the waterfront.
- End the day with a peaceful evening walk along the Corniche, reflecting on your water-filled adventures.



Driving Time

Ras Al Khaimah is easily accessible for regional and international visitors. It is also well served by excellent bus and taxi services, enabling you to reach our diverse areas of natural beauty, historical treasures and modern resorts.

A wide range of maps and brochures are also available to help you make the most of your visit to Ras Al Khaimah.

Ras Al Khaimah is only a short 45-min drive away from Dubai International Airport (DXB), and 1,5h drive away from Abu Dhabi International Airport (AUH).

Weather

Generally, Ras Al Khaimah is a few degrees cooler than its sister Emirates because of its 64-kilometre coastline and the Hajar mountain range.

With a cool sea breeze and slightly less dry in the winter than its neighbors, temperatures in the Emirate vary from 18-25°C in January to 29-43°C in July, with eight to ten daily hours of sunshine all year round.

The Jebel Jais mountain peak provides breathtaking vistas and a cooling microclimate with temperatures less than 10 degrees Fahrenheit found at sea level.

Packing Tips

Depending on the time of year you visit, ensure that you take the proper clothing to protect you. Bring plenty of layering clothes and a warm hat during the winter months. Wear a hat to shade you from the sun and plenty of sun cream to protect you from the sun's harmful rays in the summer.

Weather conditions can change quickly. It is advisable to wear multiple thin layers so that it is easy to maintain your optimal body temperature if the temperature rises or falls.

Al Naeem Mall

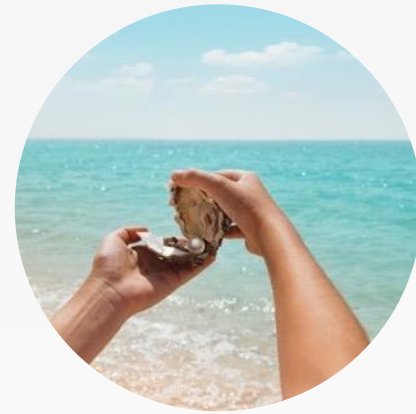
Al Naeem Mall is in the heart of Ras Al Khaimah city, located on the banks of the harbour.

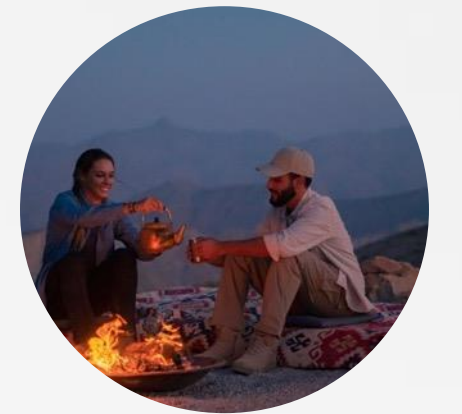

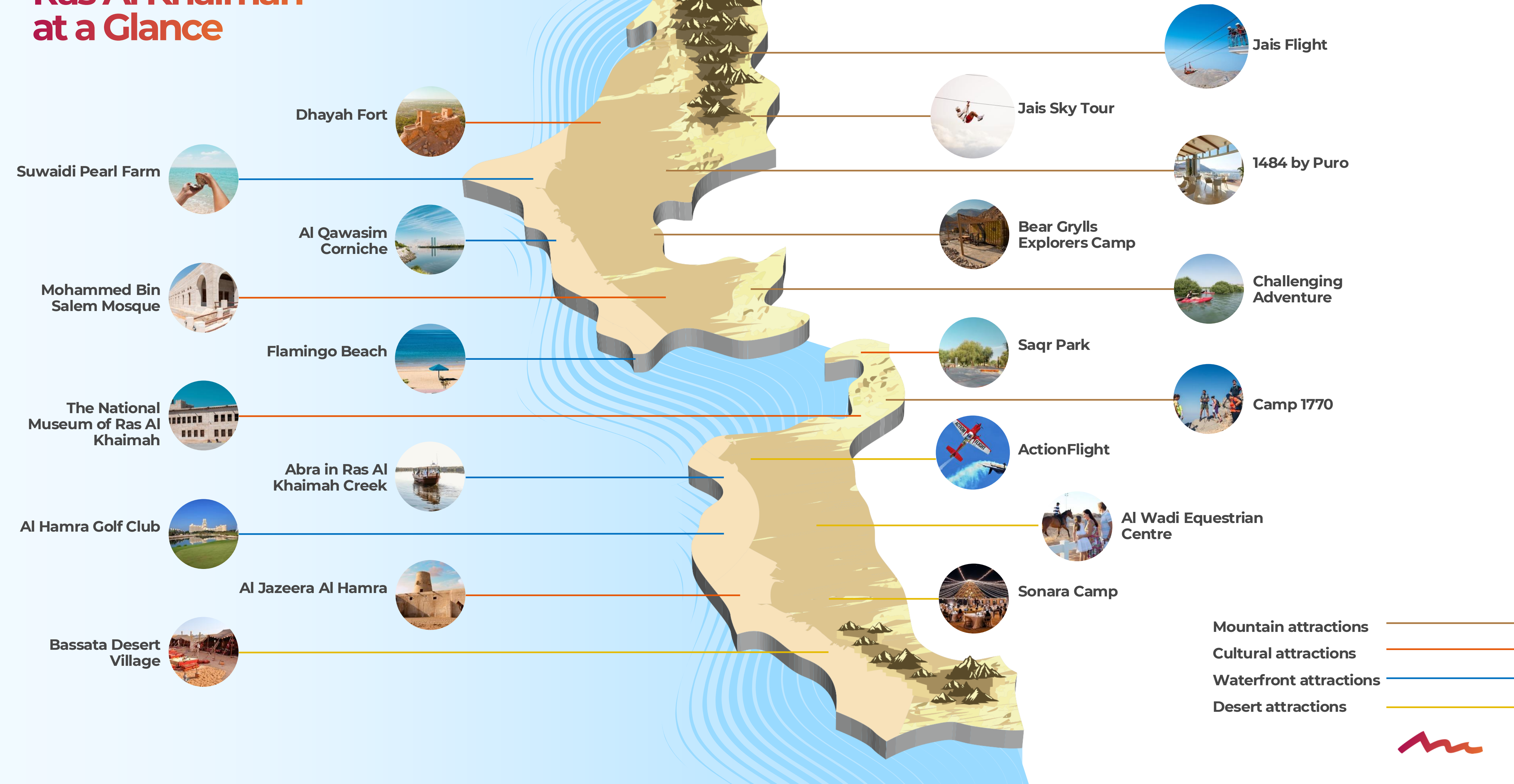
